

# **WAWOSA WhatsApp Group Rules & Regulations**

## **1. Respect and Courtesy:**

## **5. No Spam or Irrelevant Content:**

Advertisements, chain messages, unrelated videos, or repeated posts that do not concern WAWOSA activities are not permitted unless approved by admins.

## **6. Privacy and Confidentiality:**

Group information, contacts, or internal discussions must not be shared outside the group without consent.

## **7. Use Appropriate Language and Content:**

Obscene, indecent, or offensive images, videos, or messages are strictly forbidden.

## **8. Admin Authority:**

Group administrators reserve the right to warn, mute, or remove any member who violates these rules.

**9. Official Announcements:**

Members should pay attention to messages from executives or admins and avoid unnecessary comments under official announcements unless requested.
